I. Establish Quorum (66%)

Board members present were Jesse Whittenton, Julie O'Shaughnessy, Jim Rumbo and Andrew Hines. Community Association Manager Heather Hood and Assistant Community Association Manager Cindy Neale represented RealManage. Mr. Whittenton called the meeting to order at 6:37pm. Roll call was taken and proxies were certified: 31 proxies presented and 10 owners in attendance (41). Quorum of 66% (146.5 people) was not established. The meeting was adjourned and reconvened at 6:38. Quorum of 33% (73 people) was not established. The meeting was adjourned and reconvened at 6:39. Quorum of 16.5% (36.6 people) was established and the meeting was called to order.

II. Reading and Approval of Annual Meeting Minutes

Proof of Notice was displayed by Ms. Hood. The annual meeting notice was addressed and sent to the RealManage office as proof of notice that was mailed to all owners according to the Bylaws of the Association.

The 2012 Minutes were presented and approved as written. A motion to approve was carried by unanimous acclamation.
