

Summary of HOA Restrictions

The Westminster Glen Estates CC&Rs (Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions) provides a basis for neighborhood governance. The CC&Rs are part of the recorded deeds of our properties. Below is a summary of the main restrictions. For additional details and definitive text, refer to the [CC&R document](#) for the development phase that your property is in.

1. All exterior property improvements require prior approval by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). See CC&R §3.01.
2. Pets: See §4.01.
 - (a) No animals except normal domestic pets are allowed.
 - (b) Pets must not make an unreasonable amount of noise or become a nuisance.
 - (c) Pets may not be kept for hire or kenneled.
 - (d) Pets cannot run at large and must be leashed when not on the owner's property.
 - (e) Pets must be kept in a fenced yard, which must be clean and free of refuse and waste.
3. Homes must be kept in good condition and repair. See §4.02.
4. Landscaping must be maintained, including adjacent rights-of-way along roads. See §4.03
5. Running a business from a home is not allowed except for situations where specific limitations are met. See §2.01 (d).
6. No clothes drying facilities are allowed unless screened from street and neighbors. See §4.04.
7. No nuisance, obnoxious or offensive activities are allowed. No rubbish shall be allowed to accumulate. See §4.07.
8. No dumping of waste materials of any kind is allowed. See §4.08 and §4.09.
9. No burning of trash or debris is allowed. See §4.10.
10. Garbage and trash must be contained in standard containers that are kept out of sight from neighboring properties. See §4.10.
11. Discharge of firearms is not allowed. See §4.13.
12. No vehicles larger than 1-ton capacity can be kept on the property. RVs, boats, trailers, ATVs, etc. cannot be stored in view of neighboring properties. No vehicles of any kind may be operated in such a manner as to cause a nuisance. See §4.14.
13. Vehicles cannot be parked on the the street overnight. See §4.15.
